Ohio Awarded 2016 ESC Energy Stewardship Award

August 11, 2016: ESC President Tom Walther, presented the first ESC Energy Stewardship Awards to 10 states at the 5th Annual Market Transformation Conference. Awards. Ohio was recognized for a combination of state's leadership, programmatic design, and the amount of private sector investment in guaranteed energy savings performance contracting in the state.

reduce utility costs and energy and water consumption. To date, more than \$1.25 billion in energy savings projects have been implemented in Ohio as a result of a GESPC.

Breaking News: Governor vetoes voluntary clean energy goal

December 28, 2016: Governor John Kasich, vetoed a bill to make Ohio's clean energy standards voluntary for the next two years. Earlier this month the Ohio Senate passed H.B. 554 by a vote of 18-13, and the House approved the bill 55-34. The bill would freeze the state's green energy requirements. The veto came on the final day the Governor could act..

Ohio implemented its clean energy standards in 2008 and required Ohio utilities to gradually increase the share of electricity generated by renewables to 12.5 percent by 2025 and to reduce electric consumption by a cumulative 22 percent by 2025 over 2009 levels through energy efficiency programs. The standard was frozen for two-years in 2014 after passage of S.B. 310.

Athens County and Bradley
Commissioners were just two of the Ohio
public bodies approving GESPC
agreements to make buildings in their
jurisdictions more energy efficient. Athens
County is implementing a 20-year \$1.6
million contract that would touch more than
20 county buildings and structures.
Bradley County Commissioners gave
unanimous approval to an IGA for a
GESPC to modernize and update energy
systems throughout the county government
and the county schools.
